Behavior Analysts – San Diego

Behavior Analysts are encouraged to consider an outstanding career opportunity with Liberty Healthcare Corporation.

Liberty Healthcare plans to open multiple specialized residential programs in San Diego County in 2019. These programs will exclusively serve adults who have intellectual and developmental disabilities as well as significant behavioral health challenges. These individuals may also have forensic mental health concerns and likely will be transitioning into the community from a developmental center, psychiatric hospital or acute crisis facility.

Liberty's programs will all utilize intensive interdisciplinary clinical services, employ competent and well-trained direct care staff and utilize best practices in person-centered care. Each will be set in a modern four-bed residential home in the community.

The first of these new programs is scheduled to open this Spring and will be based in North County San Diego in the town of Ramona – 20 miles east of Escondido and 20 miles north of Santee.

To support the behavioral health needs of the clients of these programs, Liberty is now hiring Board Certified Behavior Analysts as well as Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analysts for multiple newly-created 'Qualified Behavior Modification Professional' positions. Both full-time and part-time positions are available.

The specific responsibilities of these positions will include:

- Providing behavior modification intervention services to a small caseload of adult clients
- Conducting functional assessments of clients to identify factors that are maintaining dangerous, maladaptive and disruptive behaviors
- Designing, implementing and monitoring the efficacy of behavioral plans
- Training staff and other stakeholders
- Actively participating in multi-disciplinary treatment team meetings
- Rapidly responding to individual client needs
- Serving as a member of the program's management team

As a Qualified Behavior Modification Professional and full-time employee of Liberty Healthcare you can expect:
